# ETHICAL PURCHASING POLICY

# PURPOSE

- Continuous Improvement Regularly review and update the policy to reflect evolving best practices in ethical purchasing.

Non-compliance with this policy may result in the termination of contracts with suppliers or disciplinary action for employees. Suppliers are encouraged to report any concerns regarding unethical practices within our supply chain.

### Environmental Responsibility

- Sustainable Products Prioritize purchasing products that are environmentally friendly, such as those made from recycled, renewable, or biodegradable materials.
- Energy Efficiency Choose energy-efficient appliances, lighting, and equipment to reduce our carbon footprint.
- Waste Reduction Implement measures to minimize waste, including sourcing products with minimal packaging and participating in recycling programs.

### Social Responsibility
